A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE MAYOR'S RE-APPOINTMENT OF TIM NAMY TO SERVE AS FIRE CHIEF FOR THE VILLAGE OF HIGHLAND HILLS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS: The position of Fire Chief is an appointive position; and

WHEREAS: The Mayor has re-appointed Tim Namy to the position of Fire Chief; and

WHEREAS: Council confirms the various appointments made by the Mayor; and

WHEREAS: Council desires to confirm this re-appointment; and

WHEREAS: It is necessary to keep an accurate record of these various appointments as to individuals appointed and their term of office.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF HIGHLAND HILLS, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

<u>Section 1</u>: That Council hereby confirms the re-appointment of Tim Namy to the position of Fire Chief for the Village of Highland Hills.

<u>Section 2</u>: That pursuant to Village Charter, the term of said appointment shall run concurrent with the remainder of the Mayor's term of Office, or until such time as a successor has been appointed and confirmed.

<u>Section 3:</u> That the annual salary of said appointed official shall be as set forth in the Village Salary and Complement.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall supersede all previously adopted resolutions or ordinances in direct conflict herewith.

Section 5: Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an orderly meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were conducted in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
