AN ORDINANCE MAKING TEMPORARY APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FIRST QUARTER OF CALENDAR YEAR 2025 FOR THE CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF HIGHLAND HILLS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, there will be at the end of the calendar year 2024 certain unencumbered balances and an anticipated sum of money sufficient to take care of current expenses and other expenditures in the funds of the Village of Highland Hills, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, such amounts are/or will be available in any and all events for appropriations for the current expenses and other expenditure of the Village within the first quarter of calendar year 2025, and the members of this Council now wish to appropriate such amounts as may be found necessary to meet the current expenses and other expenditures for the first quarter from January 1, 2025 through March 31, 2025.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF HIGHLAND HILLS, OHIO:

<u>Section 1</u>: To provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of the Village of Highland Hills, Ohio, for the first quarter of the fiscal year 2025 from January 1, 2025 through March 31, 2025, the following sums be and they are hereby appropriated as itemized on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as if fully written.

<u>Section 2</u>: The Finance Director is hereby authorized to draw warrants for the payments from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by the officers authorized by law to approve same, or in Ordinance of Council to make the expenditures; however, that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries, or wages, except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinances.

Section 3: Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an orderly meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were conducted in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements, including

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Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary to provide for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Highland Hills and for the orderly operations of the Village in order to meet payroll and various expenses immediately beginning in January, 2025, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage, otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
